REFLECTION: After calling the first disciples Jesus went around all of Galilee. Following Jesus does not make us hermits in a desert. It takes us to the world. But its powers have no longer hold over us, no more pursuit of selfish interests, accumulation of possessions or stepping over people to satisfy our ambition. We notice three things in Jesus' public ministry in Galilee. He taught in synagogues. The Jewish people were learners and met in the synagogue to study the word of God. We too remain learners no matter how long we have studied God's word. We do not listen enough to God's word and have not allowed it to inspire us. When we listen enough to the gospel, we first make a sign of the cross on our forehead. It shows the readiness of our minds to listen. Jesus proclaimed the gospel of the kingdom. The second sign of the cross at the gospel is on our lips. The word of God we received is not for private consumption or personal salvation only. Like any of God's gifts, it is to be shared. We make the third sign of the cross on our breast, precisely because our proclamation will not be effective if there is no loving heart behind it. Jesus went around curing every disease and illness among the people. If it is a message of hope and love, it will transform people's life.
